



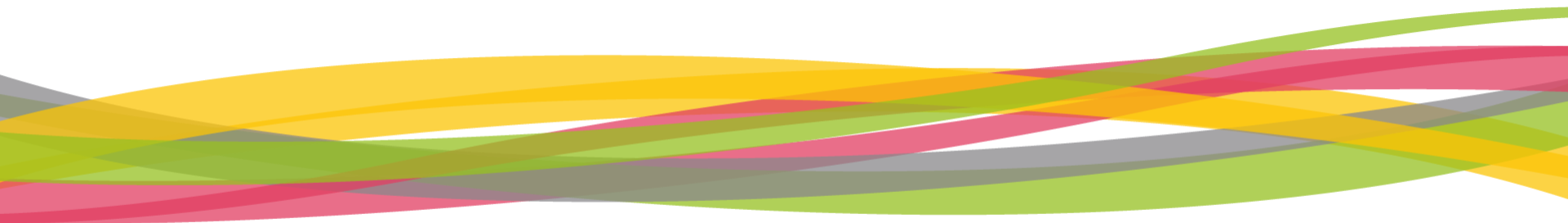

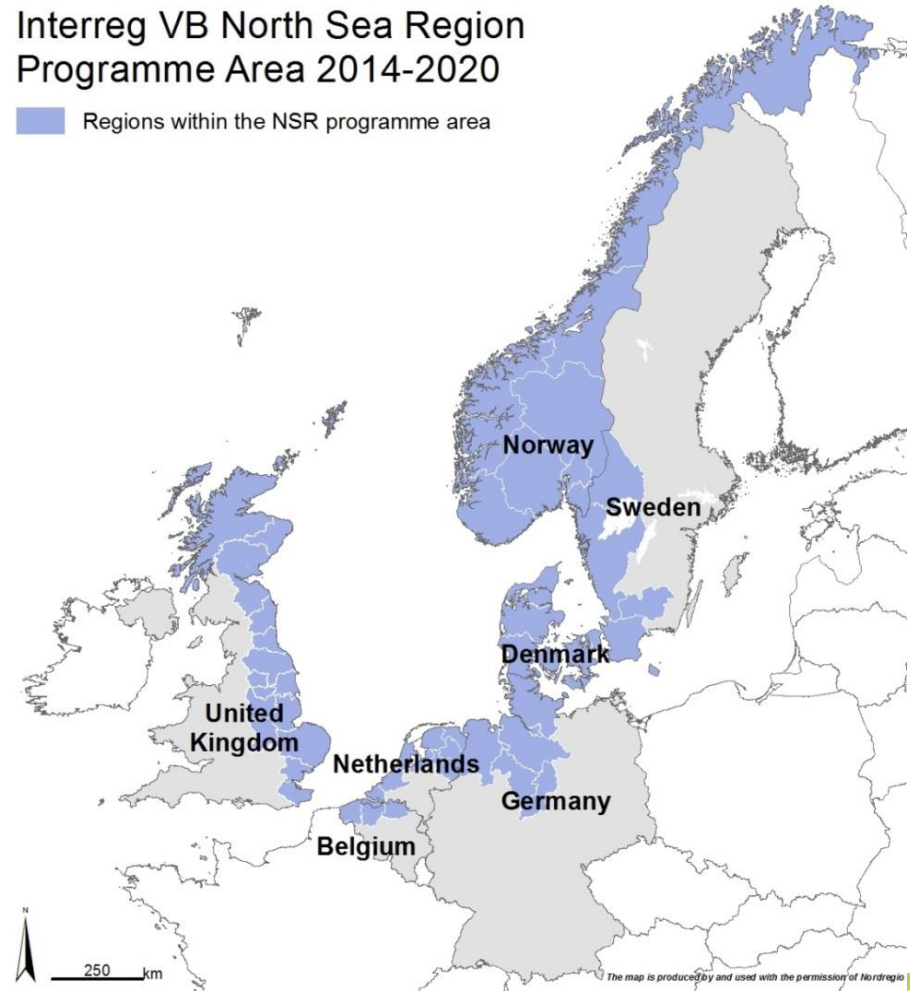

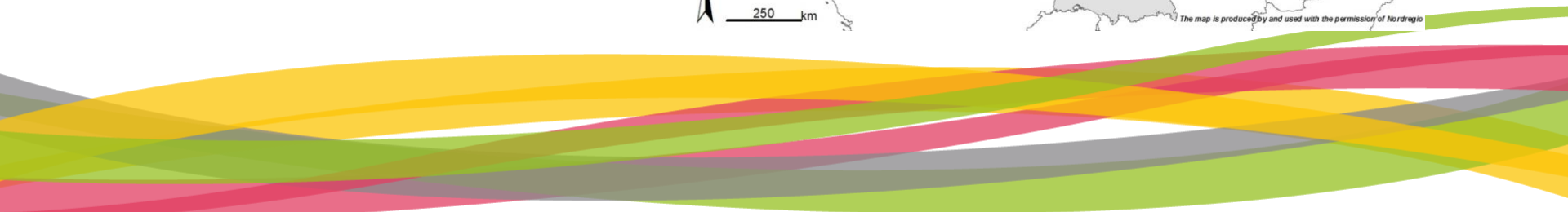


Interreg VB North Sea Region Programme Area 2014-2020

Regions within the NSR programme area

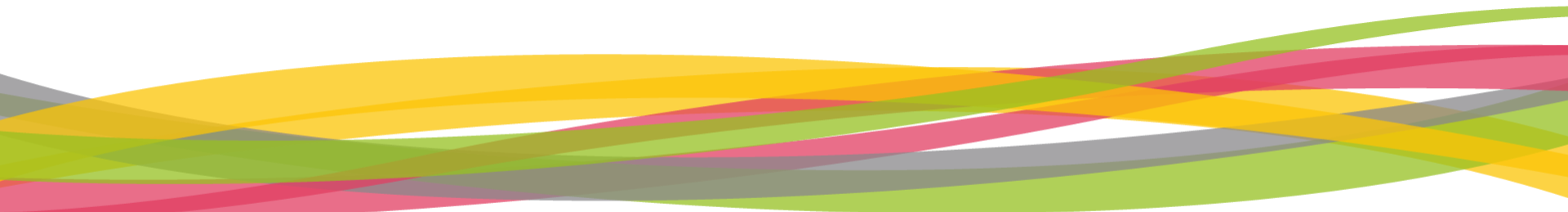

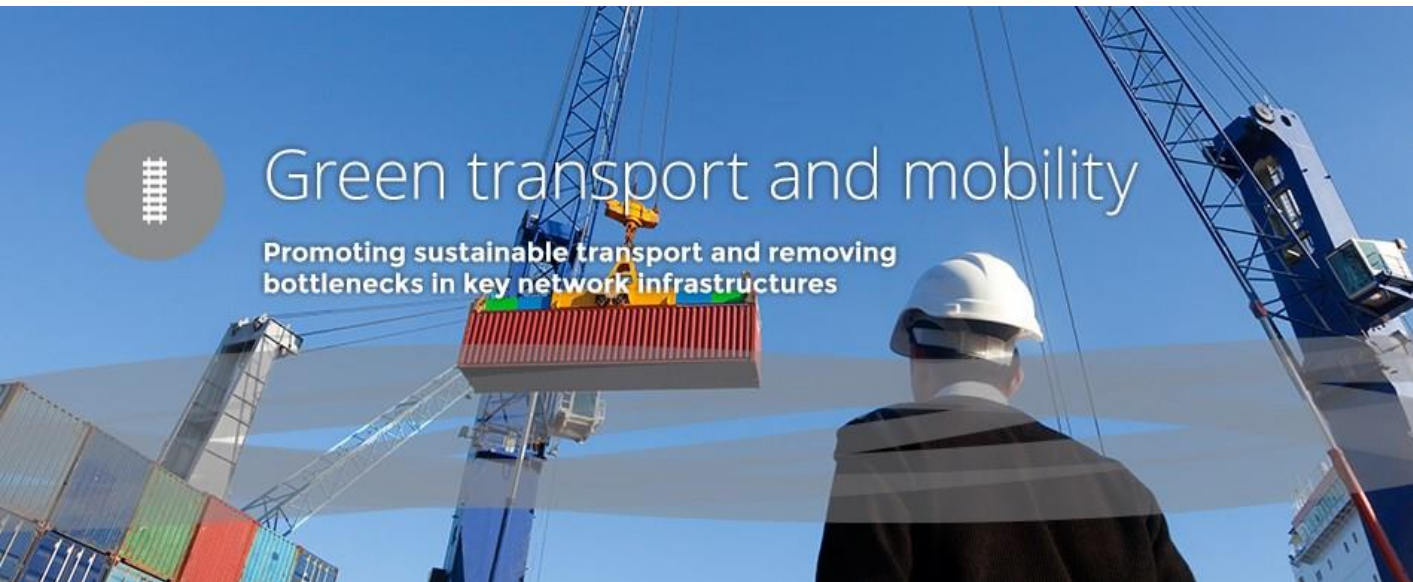

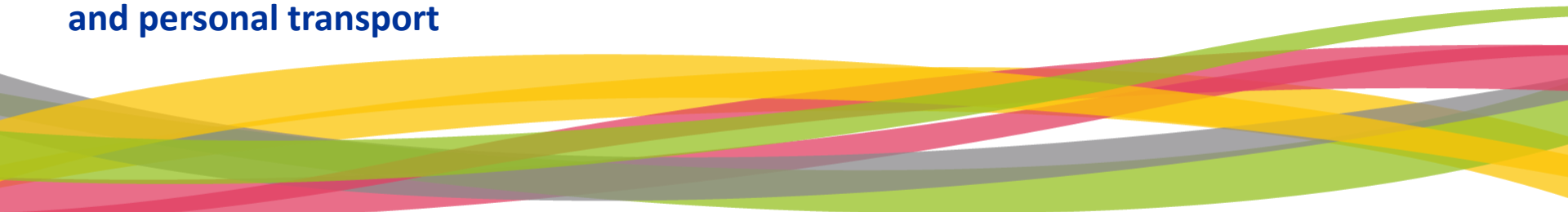
2.1 Promote the development and adoption of products, services and processes to accelerate greening of the North Sea Region economy

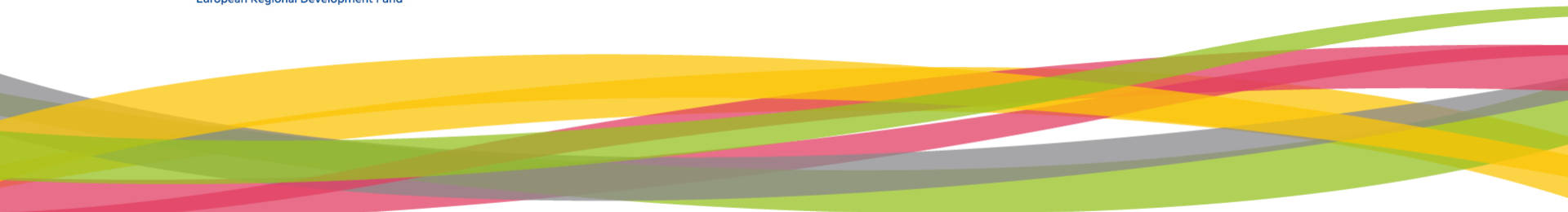

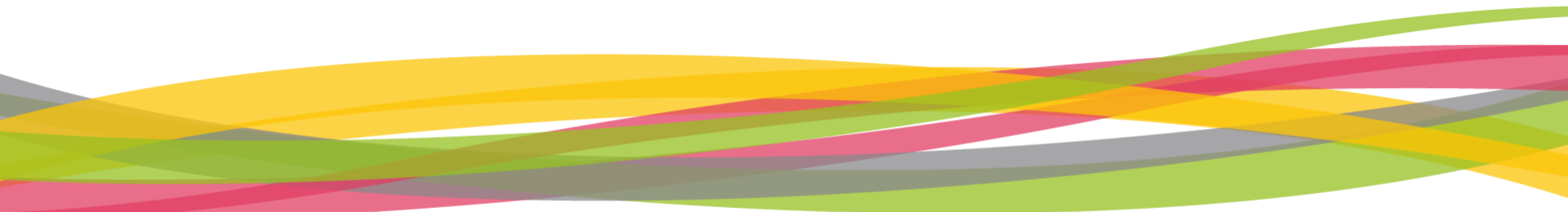

- Our programme has adjusted its payment scheme since the previous period to make it easier for small organisations to participate.
- That said, companies must be aware of the rules and able to commit within the parameters of the programme.
